The importance of Grant Management

- Continue to inspire clubs to contribute at least \$100 per capita to the Annual Fund and to encourage all Rotarians to leave a legacy to the Foundation through the Endowment.
- Assist district chairs in helping clubs find international partners, complete community assessments, and use all of their District Designated Funds (DDF) each year.






Progress as of 31 March 2018 \$133 million
